The ICAC offers two QME tracks, to apply for, and become a QME licensed by California DWC Medical-Unit.

TRACK 1: 44-hours of five – days of ZOOM classes (no classroom – no travel, no room or board expenses).

TRACK 2: 25-hours to include: Currently scheduled for March 28-30, 2025, in Santa Ana, California

(2) 4 hours of California Case Law (2-hours) & Anti-bias Training (2-hours) (Zoom)
